MySchedule Bulk Collection

New Program for Youngtown in 2021

Parks & Sons is excited to announce an improved bulk collection program to residents of Youngtown! The new program, called MySchedule, allows residents to schedule bulk collections throughout the year according to their needs. MySchedule replaces the two town-wide spring and fall collections that were scheduled for all residents on the same day. With the new program, each resident can schedule up to two bulk collections per year on weeks that are convenient for them and are included in the cost of service (additional collections available for a fee).

This service provides an easy and convenient way for residents to dispose of items generated from their homes which are too large to dispose of in a regular trash container. **Collection is offered to Parks & Sons customers with active residential service and an account in good standing.**

SCHEDULE

To schedule a collection, use the MySchedule online portal at www.parksandsons.com/myschedule. Each resident may schedule up to two (2) bulk collections each calendar year. Appointments are available for booking up to 60 days in advance. **To ensure service, you must schedule in advance and must have your items out at the curb no later than 5:30am on the day of collection.**

PLACEMENT

Materials must be placed in the street up against the curb (gutter) in front of your property. Where there is no curb, material must be placed at the edge of the street. Bulk trash cannot be placed on the sidewalk or on private property. EXCEPTION: Bulk trash cannot be placed on high capacity roads (i.e. 111th Avenue) – in this case only, trash must be placed on the resident's property (signed liability waiver required). **DO NOT PLACE ITEMS IN THE ALLEY. Bulk trash must be at least five (5) feet from any object that could be damaged during the collection. Do not lean against fences or walls.** All materials must be neatly stacked. Piles should not exceed 8 feet long by 6 feet wide by 4 feet tall (or approximately a ¾ ton pick-up truck full). Crews may only spend 20 minutes per residence for piles who are not compliant with this limit. Material left behind must be removed from the curb by the resident and crews will not return until the next regularly scheduled collection.

CONTAINMENT

Bag and tie all leaves, grass, and smaller yard clippings. It must be bagged or boxed and securely contained to be collected. Collection crews are responsible for the removal of large debris only. The equipment used often leaves behind small debris, which is your responsibility to clean up (please sweep or rake after collection, if necessary).

All residents are required to be in compliance with Town Codes and Ordinances, and HOA Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions. It is your responsibility – failure to comply will result in further action.

Items not out in time or listed as unacceptable will not be collected and you will be required to remove them within two days following the collection as scheduled. PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- **You choose the day:** schedule a date that is convenient for you (January through December)
- **Schedule online:** book your appointment online in advance – schedule early to reserve your slot
- **2 collections included per year:** each home may schedule up to two collections per calendar year

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- **Appliances:** stoves, washers, dryers, water heaters, microwaves, televisions. Appliances that use refrigerants are considered hazardous and will NOT be accepted in the collection.
- **Furniture:** sofas, chairs, tables, bookcases, desks, patio furniture, exercise equipment, mattresses.
- **Yard Waste:** tree limbs, cacti, yard clippings, grass, leaves. *Must be contained in bags or boxes!*
- **Wood:** fences, tree trunks less than 8 inches in diameter.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS (NOT INCLUDED IN COLLECTION)

- **Hazardous Waste:** motor oil, paint, paint thinner, cleaners, gasoline, batteries, appliances containing refrigerants (such as freezers, refrigerators, air conditioners)
- **Household trash**
- **Medical or Animal Waste**
- **Inert materials:** rocks, bricks, pavers, dirt, block, concrete, tile, asphalt, roofing shingles.
- **Auto Parts:** tires, motors.
- **Construction/Demolition Debris:** glass doors/windows, mirrors.
