CREDIT TIME SERVED APPLICATION

I understand that I may be entitled to time-served credit of not less than \$150 per day for my Class C offense filed in the Arlington Municipal Court because:

- I am currently incarcerated and serving a sentence for other offenses in a jail or prison facility or was incarcerated and served a sentence for other offenses in a jail or prison facility <u>after</u> the commission of the above-listed offense(s) for which I am seeking credit; <u>OR</u>
- 2. I was arrested on these warrant(s) by another agency and held for transfer to the Arlington jail; and,



I was not transferred because I bonded out on the warrant(s); or,

I was released because the Arlington Police Department did not come pick me up.

If neither of the above-requirements are met, you may not qualify for time-served credit. <u>If released due to non pickup by</u> <u>the Arlington Police Department, you may qualify for partial credit</u>. You will need to contact the Court to request a date to see the judge. The judge will review your case(s) to determine the amount earned and discuss all options for satisfying the balance(s) owed. If your case(s) are still in warrant status, you may be required to post a bond to clear the warrant(s) to set your case(s) for Court. You may also request a payment plan or an indigency review to see if you qualify for a non-monetary option to satisfy the amount you owe.

Arlington is a Safe Harbor Court which means that persons may appear to discuss options to resolve their outstanding cases without fear of being arrested on warrants issued by the Arlington Municipal Court.

Unless I have been previously adjudicated as guilty, my signature below serves as a plea of NO CONTEST on the charge(s) listed above and a waiver of my right to a jury trial. <u>I understand that if I am granted time-served credit, the case(s) will</u> <u>be reported as conviction(s) to the DPS and may affect my driver's license and/or criminal history</u>. I attest that my application meets one of the above requirements <u>and that I am attaching the required proof of incarceration</u> which includes the date of arrest, the date of release from custody, and the offenses for which I was serving a sentence.* I understand that a judge will review the application and provide me with a written order granting or denying time-served credit. I understand that I remain responsible for any balance owed, and that I will begin a payment plan, request an indigency review, or pay the balance in full as ordered.

I acknowledge that if credit for time served is granted, my case(s) will be closed as a conviction(s) and reported to the DPS to be included on my criminal history and/or driving record.
