

Patron Access to Youth Services Area Policy

- I. **Purpose:** The designated youth services area of any Aurora Public Library is designed to serve the needs of children and teens.

- II. **Use of the youth services area:** Certain spaces in the library are designated for youth use and youth services. Adults in the youth services area who are not using the collection or specific services offered may be asked to exit the area and use other areas of the library. Public computers in the youth services area are to be used only by youth and their caregivers. Groups or individuals seeking youth resources and access to youth materials are welcome including teachers, students, adults accompanying a child, and adults with intellectual or developmental disabilities.

- III. **Restrooms in the youth services area:** Unless accompanied by a child, adults are not to use any restroom located in the youth services area of any Aurora Public Library.
