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About The NCS™

The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™) report is about the "livability" of Los Alamos County. A livable community is a place that is not simply habitable, but that is desirable. It is not only where people do live, but where they want to live. The survey was developed by the experts from National Research Center at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, private sector, community-based organizations and residents, all geographically connected. The NCS captures residents' opinions considering ten central facets of a community:

- Economy
- Mobility
- Community Design
- Utilities
- Safety
- Natural Environment
- Parks and Recreation
- Health and Wellness
- Education, Arts, and Culture
- Inclusivity and Engagement

The report provides the opinions of a representative sample of 2,800 residents of the County of Los Alamos County collected from December 5, 2022 to January 16, 2023. The margin of error around any reported percentage is 4% for all respondents and the response rate for the 2022 survey was 23%. Survey results were weighted so that the demographic profile of respondents was representative of the demographic profile of adults in Los Alamos County.





How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative resident opinion is comprised of resident perspectives gathered in surveys from over 600 communities whose residents evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Community Survey. The comparison evaluations are from the most recent survey completed in each community in the last five years. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. The communities in the database represent a wide geographic and population range. In each tab, Los Alamos County's results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Los Alamos County residents is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Los Alamos County's average rating for a particular item was more than 10 points different than the benchmark. If a rating was "much higher" or "much lower," then Los Alamos County's average rating was more than 20 points different when compared to the benchmark.

The survey was administered during the COVID-19 pandemic, a time of challenge for many local governments. While we provide comparisons to national benchmarks, it is important to note that much of the benchmark data was collected prior to the pandemic. This may impact how your County's 2022 ratings compare to other communities' ratings from the past five years.

Trends over time

Trend data for Los Alamos County represent important comparison data and should be examined for improvements or declines*. Deviations from stable trends over time represent opportunities for understanding how local policies, programs, or public information may have affected residents' opinions. Changes between survey years have been noted with an arrow and the percent difference. If the difference is greater than six percentage points between the 2019 and 2022 surveys, the change is statistically significant.

* In 2020, The NCS survey was updated to include new and refreshed items. Consequently, some of the trends may be impacted due to wording modifications that could have potentially altered the meaning of the item for the respondent.

Methods

Selecting survey recipients

All households within the County of Los Alamos County were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all households within the zip codes serving Los Alamos County was purchased from Go-Dog Direct based on updated listings from the United States Postal Service. Since some of the zip codes that serve the County of Los Alamos County households may also serve addresses that lie outside of the community, the exact geographic location of each housing unit was compared to community boundaries using the most current municipal boundary file. Addresses located outside of the County of Los Alamos County boundaries were removed from the list of potential households to survey. Each address identified as being within county boundaries was further identified as being within one of the seven subareas. From that list, addresses were randomly selected as survey recipients, with multi-family housing units (defined as those with a unit number) sampled at a rate of 5:3 compared to single family housing units.

An individual within each household was selected using the birthday method. The birthday method selects a person within the household by asking the "person whose birthday has most recently passed" to complete the questionnaire. The underlying assumption in this method is that day of birth has no relationship to the way people respond to surveys. This instruction was contained in the introduction of the survey.

Conducting the survey

The 2,800 randomly selected households received mailings beginning on December 5, 2020 and the survey remained open for 6 weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the household to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained a cover letter with instructions, the survey questionnaire, and a postage-paid return envelope. All mailings included a web link to give residents the opportunity to respond to the survey online. All follow-up mailings asked those who had not completed the survey to do so and those who had already done so to refrain from completing the survey again.

About 3% of the 2,800 mailed invitations or surveys were returned because the household address was vacant or the postal service was unable to deliver the survey as addressed. Of the remaining 2,730 households that received the invitations to participate, 630 completed the survey, providing an overall response rate of 23%. The response rate was calculated using AAPOR's response rate #2* for mailed surveys of unnamed persons.

It is customary to describe the precision of estimates made from surveys by a "level of confidence" and accompanying "confidence interval" (or margin of error). A traditional level of confidence, and the one used here, is 95%. The 95% confidence interval can be any size and quantifies the sampling error or imprecision of the survey results because some residents' opinions are relied on to estimate all residents' opinions. The margin of error for the County of Los Alamos County survey is no greater than plus or minus five percentage points around any given percent reported for all respondents (630 completed surveys).

In addition to the randomly selected "probability sample" of households, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the County of Los Alamos County. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all county residents and became available on January 2, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks. The data presented in the following tabs exclude the open participation survey data, but a tab at the end provides the complete frequency of responses to questions by the open participation respondents.

Analyzing the data

Responses from mailed surveys were entered into an electronic dataset using a "key and verify" method, where all responses are entered twice and compared to each other. Any discrepancies were resolved in comparison to the original survey form. Range checks as well as other forms of quality control were also performed. Responses from surveys completed on Polco were downloaded and merged with the mailed survey responses.

The demographics of the survey respondents were compared to those found in the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the County of Los Alamos County. The primary objective of weighting survey data is to make the survey respondents reflective of the larger population of the community. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the probability sample are presented in the following table.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Key Findings

Most residents feel a strong sense of safety in Los Alamos County.

Nearly all ratings related to safety all scored on par with or higher than benchmark comparisons. Close to 96% of residents positively rated the overall feeling of safety in Los Alamos County, which scored much higher that comparison communities nationwide. Virtually all residents (at least 98%) said they felt very safe or somewhat safe in their neighborhood during the day, and in downtown/commercial areas during the day. Similarly, 9 in 10 reported feeling safe from property crime and from violent crime. About 6 in 10 reported feeling safe from fire, flood or other natural disaster, a seven-point decline from 2020's survey.

The County's safety services also received high marks from respondents. About 9 in 10 gave positive reviews to fire services, ambulance or emergency medical services, crime prevention, Police/Sheriff services, and fire prevention and education. Just over 8 in 10 participants did the same for animal control and emergency preparedness.

Economy is an important area of focus for the County.

Residents offered high ratings of importance (88% essential or very important) and lower ratings around quality (64% excellent or good) to the overall economic health of Los Alamos County, suggesting that the economy is a priority and an area of focus for the community. Roughly 8 in 10 residents positively rated Los Alamos County as a place to work, and employment opportunities are on the rise, jumping 13 points since 2020 (49% excellent or good in 2022; compared to 36% in 2020). Conversely, shopping opportunities and the variety of business and service establishments were favorably evaluated by less than 1 in 10 participants, both scoring much lower than national benchmarks. Declines were seen in ratings of the overall quality of business and service establishments (32% excellent or good in 2022; compared to 41% in 2020) and economic development (20% excellent or good in 2022; compared to 29% in 2020). Ratings related to affordability also tended to be low, indicating a potential opportunity for growth. Cost of living was rated positively by only about 14% of residents, and when asked what impact, if any, the economy would likely have on their family income in the next six months, only 12% of residents expected the impact to be somewhat or very positive, both scoring lower than the national benchmark.

Residents identify the community's utility infrastructure as a priority.

When asked which aspects of the community Los Alamos County should focus on in the next two years, 90% of residents identified the overall utility infrastructure as a priority. About half of participants gave high marks to the quality of the utility infrastructure in Los Alamos County, a 23-point drop since 2020. Sewer services, storm water management, drinking water, and garbage collection all had strong ratings, with close to 9 in 10 residents offering excellent or good reviews. Power (electric and/or gas) utilities showed a significant decline since 2020 (62% excellent or good in 2022; compared to 87% in 2020), indicating a potential area of focus. Close to 4 in 10 residents positively evaluated affordable high-speed internet access, scoring lower than benchmark comparisons.

The natural environment in Los Alamos County is highly valued by survey participants.

Ratings for survey items related to the County's natural environment tended to be positive and on par with or above national averages. About 95% of residents gave excellent or good reviews to the overall quality of natural environment in Los Alamos County. About 9 in 10 offered positive evaluations of the County's air quality and open spaces, both of which scored higher than national benchmarks. Additionally, close to 8 in 10 residents favorably rated cleanliness, preservation of natural areas, recycling, and yard waste pick up. One survey item that stood out in this area, with a 43 point decline since 2020, was water resources, which were rated 39% excellent or good in this survey iteration (compared to 82% in 2020), which may merit additional research and consideration.

Facets of livability

Resident perceptions of quality and importance for each of the facets of community livability provide an overview of community strengths and challenges that are useful for planning, budgeting and performance evaluation.

The charts below show the proportion of residents who rated the community facets positively for quality and the priority (importance) placed on each. Also displayed is whether local ratings were lower, similar, or higher than communities across the country (the national benchmark).

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
Balancing performance and importance

Every jurisdiction must balance limited resources while meeting resident needs and striving to optimize community livability. To this end, it is helpful to know what aspects of the community are most important to residents and which they perceive as being of higher or lower quality. It is especially helpful to know when a facet of livability is considered of high importance but rated as lower quality, as this should be a top priority to address.

To help guide County staff and officials with decisions on future resource allocation, resident ratings of the importance of services were compared to their ratings of the quality of these services. To identify the services perceived by residents to have relatively lower quality at the same time as relatively higher importance, all services were ranked from highest perceived quality to lowest perceived quality and from highest perceived importance to lowest perceived importance. Some services were in the top half of both lists (higher quality and higher importance); some were in the top half of one list but the bottom half of the other (higher quality and lower importance or lower quality and higher importance); and some services were in the bottom half of both lists.


Services receiving quality ratings of excellent or good by 70% or more of respondents were considered of "higher quality" and those with ratings lower than 70% were considered to be of "lower quality." Services were classified as "more important" if they were rated as essential or very important by 69% or more of respondents. Services were rated as "less important" if they received a rating of less than 69%. This classification uses the median ratings for quality and importance to divide the services in half.

The quadrants in the figure below show which community facets were given higher or lower importance ratings (right-left) and which had higher or lower quality ratings (up-down). Facets of livability falling closer to a diagonal line from the lower left to the upper right are those where performance ratings are more commensurate with resident priorities. Facets scoring closest to the lower right hand corner of the matrix (higher in importance and lower in quality) are those that may warrant further investigation to see if changes to their delivery are necessary to improve their performance. This is the key part of this chart on which to focus. Facets falling in the top left hand corner of the chart (lower in importance but higher in quality) are areas where performance may outscore resident priorities, and may be a consideration for lower resource allocation.




Please rate each of the following aspects of quality of life in Los Alamos County. (% excellent or good)





Overall economic health of Los Alamos County, 2022




What impact, if any, do you think the economy will have on your family income in the next 6 months? Do you think the impact will be:















Methods (open participation)

As part of its participation in The National Community Survey™ (The NCS™), the County of Los Alamos County conducted a survey of 2,800 residents. Survey invitations were mailed to randomly selected households and data were collected from December 5, 2022 to January 16, 2023. The results from this main survey effort represent the most robust estimate of your residents' opinions.

After the above data collection period was underway, a link to an online open participation survey was publicized by the County of Los Alamos County. The open participation survey was identical to the probability sample survey with two small updates; it included a map at the beginning asking where the respondent lives and also a question about where they heard about the survey. The open participation survey was open to all county residents and became available on January 2, 2023. The survey remained open for 2 weeks and there were 585 responses.

The open participation survey data were not collected through a random sample and it is unknown who in the community was aware of the survey; therefore, a level of confidence in the representativeness of the sample cannot be estimated. However, to reduce bias where possible, these data were statistically weighted to match the demographic characteristics of the 2010 Census and 2020 American Community Survey estimates for adults in the County of Los Alamos County. The characteristics used for weighting were age, sex, race, Hispanic origin, housing type, housing tenure, and area. No adjustments were made for design effects. Weights were calculated using an iterative, multiplicative raking model known as the ANES Weighting Algorithm.* The results of the weighting scheme for the open participation survey are presented in the following table.
